### What is this workshop about?

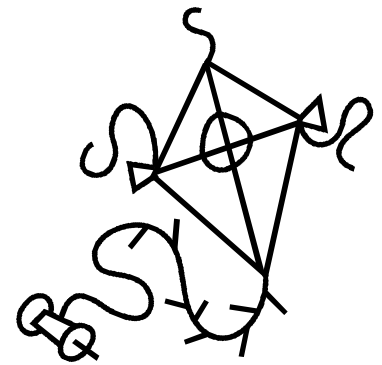


The workshop is a chance for your people to take part in a range of activities that stem from different world cultures that are now commonly part of life in the UK.

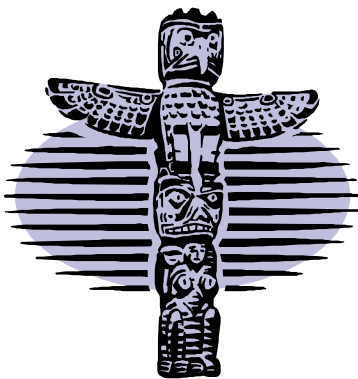
Each activity is a something fun to do in its own right but also a chance to learn about other people and other places, to share knowledge and experiences and broaden horizons.

### What actually happens in a workshop?

- Kite Making –China (materials must be provided)
- Origami – Japan (materials must be provided)
- Totem Poles – Native American/Canadian (materials must be provided)
