Working alongside you to deliver work to the young people in your club/group/project around the theme of Active Citizenship. There are four key aspects to the project: Peer Education, Personal and Social Education, Young Leader Training & Participation and Accrediting Young People's Learning.

Momentum Project:

First Gear and On Two Wheels

Road safety courses designed for young people who are about to start learning to drive a car or ride a motorbike. The courses cover vehicle control, basic maintenance and safety checks and explore positive attitudes to road use.

Youth Programme Events

The YCHLOW Youth Programme Group organises a variety of events for youth clubs/projects/groups to participate in. Some are run in the club's own venue (e.g. postal quizzes) while others are at a central venue.

Types of club visits include:

Observation

Opportunity to assist clubs to review their youth work practices, to offer support in all areas and to encourage and facilitate Best Practise.

Programme Development

Enabling youth workers and/or senior members to develop their work with young people. Available workshop activities include: Juggling and Circus Skills, Face Painting, Initiative Challenges, Healthy Lifestyles, Banner Making and T-Shirt Painting. Usually these workshops are completed in one session.

The following resources are all available for use by our members either during a club visit from one of our staff or on a short term loan basis.
