Aim

- ☞ To assist young people to take responsibilities within their youth group/club/project and develop their personal and social skills and to deliver peer education
- ☞ To enable adult leaders to support young people in developing the skills needed to be more involved in the running of their group/club/project

You will

- ☞ Nominate young people from your club/group/project for young leader training
- ☞ Provide a supporting statement as to why the young person should take part
- ☞ Gain young people who are actively engaged in the development of the group/project/club
- ☞ Support young people to achieve success in this training

Young people will

- ☞ Gain the skills needed to help with the planning and delivery of sessions in their club/group/project
- ☞ Sign a contract outlining the objectives of the training
- ☞ Have a portfolio of evidence of their involvement
- ☞ Receive certificates

We will:

- ☞ Collect nomination and application forms
- ☞ Visit and have a chat about the project
- ☞ Help to draw up contracts with the young people to help in the understanding of their role.
- ☞ Visit the nominees once a month for six months and
- ☞ Collect evidence for a portfolio of work
- ☞ Present certificates
